

"Mastering Tenses: A Dynamic Exploration Of English Language Proficiency"

Among all the activities carried out thus far in the realm of learning English as a language, the tense activity holds a special significance. This particular activity is conducted in both 7th and 8th grades. Following the instruction of the topic, the students were divided into four groups. Each group provided an affirmative sentence, a negative sentence, a question, and a negative question as examples, all employing the same subject and verb.



The subsequent group was tasked with transforming these sentences into the present continuous, present perfect, and present perfect continuous tenses. In the subsequent phase, each group swapped their sentences to perfect each tense. This pattern continued for past and future tenses, with a focus on practicing rather than mere recall. The activity has proven to be quite rewarding.

"Unveiling Science: Igniting Curiosity Through Hands-on Discovery"

The science laboratory is a place where students practically observe the proof of the concepts learned in theory. The students of Ambitus World School in Vijayawada were engaged in the subject and performed experiments with great enthusiasm in a professional scientific environment. 


