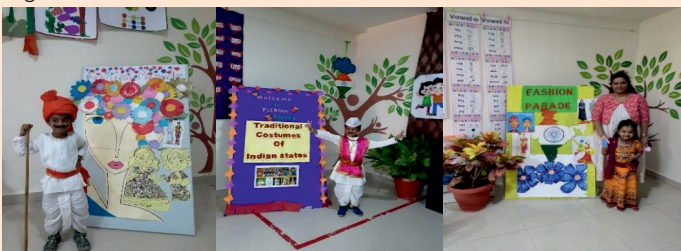
Friendship Day

Ambiqest, the event to unlock the secrets of innovation.

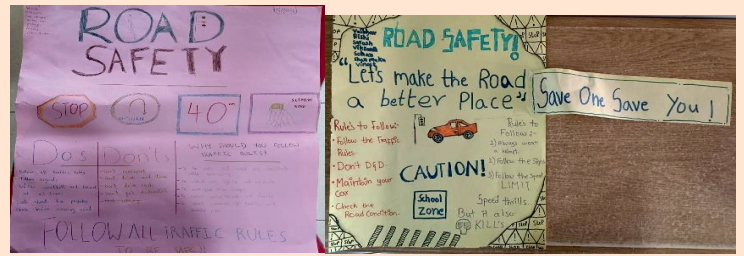

Light and shadow activity

Grade IX Biology Activity

The learners conducted an experiment using potted plants to observe the process of transpiration. One plant was covered with a transparent plastic bag, encompassing both the plant and pot, while the other plant had a transparent plastic bag covering only the soil and pot. After placing both plants under sunlight for 24 hours, the learners were thrilled to discover water droplets on the inner surface of the plastic bag that enveloped the whole plant. This observation helped them gain a better understanding of the process of transpiration.
